PAGEANT DAY – Saturday 8 December 2018

Floats are to assemble on Bridge Terrace from **3:00 pm** with all floats to be in position no later than 3:45 pm. The pageant parade will commence at 4:00 pm concluding with the arrival of Father Christmas at Grosvenor Gardens at approximately 5:30 pm. The pageant will be followed by our Carols by the Sea presentation.

ADVICE TO PAGEANT PARTICIPANTS REGARDING RIDING ON FLOATS

Whilst exemptions exist for participants operating within the CLOSED road controlled area of the Pageant, all operators **MUST** provide a safe environment for both the operators, users and spectators. The onus lies directly with the operator of the vehicle to ensure a safe system is in place for all concerned.

The intention of the Pageant organisers is to have a safe and incident free event. To this end, traffic marshals will be in place to assist with traffic and pedestrian safety. All vehicle operators **MUST** ensure that they abide by instructions provided and to act in a safe manner at all times.

Please assist with the safe management of this pageant by planning the delivery and collection of the people on your float and ensure it is a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.
