The food stalls proved very popular and it was good to see some of the shops in Ocean Street remain open a bit later than usual.

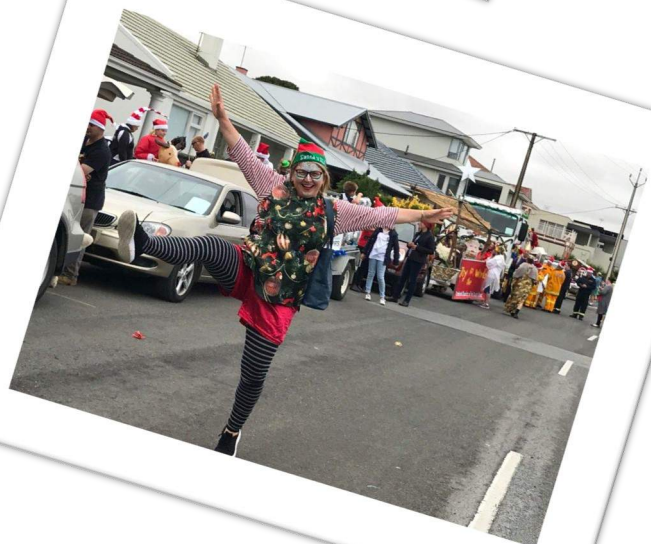
The crowd were well behaved and appreciated the Santa Run before the pageant started.
