What an interesting meeting last week .We heard from Melanie Sjoberg who is President of the Friends of the Heysen Trail.

The Heysen Trail is 1200 Km long and goes from Cape Jervis to Blinman in the Flinders Ranges.

It is estimated that if you walked it from start to finish it would take 60 days at approx. 20km/ day. Along the trail there is no e-mail or phone access.

The trail was named after Sir Hans Heysen and 60% of it is on private property access to which was negotiated by Terry Lavender.

It is an Adventure trail which covers history, geology and agriculture of the areas it passes through.as well as walkers learn about the Indigenous people who were in the area.

Small towns along the trail benefit from hikers spending money for provisions in the stores.

The Friends of the Heysen Trail has 1200 members and has a Council, Committees and runs an office 5 days a week.

Melanie distributed copies of the Friends magazine "trail Walker" which has details of their activities and a map of the Trail.

A very good evening from a person who is very involved in the Friends group.
